Diagnosis: Systemic Mastocytosis
Systemic Mastocytosis is characterised by an abnormal proliferation of mast cells in the bone marrow, liver, spleen and/or lymph nodes. Signs and symptoms are mainly related to the release of mast cell mediators, causing flushing, itching, osteoporosis, gastrointestinal symptoms such as diarrhoea and pain, and even syncope or anaphylactic attacks with shock. Specific measures need to be taken in case of surgery or radiology if contrast media have to be used.
